

Decision No. 2.Fpk.3158/2016/20
of the Metropolitan Court of Budapest
on the Publication of the Opening of Winding-up Proceedings

The Court orders the publication of the fact that it has ordered the winding-up of debtor Trophy Holding Nyilvánosan Működő Részvénytársaság (registered office: 1054 Budapest, Szabadság tér 7., company registration number: 01-10-048852, tax number: 23705373-2-41).

The date of filing of the petition for the opening of winding-up proceedings: the 15th day of August 2016.

The starting date of the winding-up proceedings will be the day on which this Decision is published on the website of the Company Gazette.

The liquidator appointed by the Court: CREDIT PLUSZ Felszámoló és Vagyonkezelő Korlátolt Felelősségű Társaság (registered office: 1119 Budapest, Vahot utca 6. fszt./14., tax number: 10601169-2-43).

The receiver: László Nagy (1119 Budapest, Vahot utca 6. fszt./14., date of birth: 13 January 1958, tax identification number: 8332491274, mother's maiden name: Julianna Kiss).

The number of the special account managed by the Financial Administration Office of the Metropolitan Court of Budapest: 10032000-01483013-24000004.

All those [including lien holders and the holders of contingent claims as defined in Section 3 (1) g)] who as creditors wish to enforce their known claims against the debtor – other than the ones already notified and registered during bankruptcy proceedings conducted immediately before the winding-up proceedings [Section 27 (2) e)] – during the winding-up proceedings should report their known claims to the liquidator within 40 (forty) days of the publication of this Decision.

With the exception of the claims specified in Sections 57 (1) a) and c) of amended Act XLIX of 1991, the liquidator will only register those claims on which the creditor has paid 1% (one per cent) of the principal amount of the claim, but minimum HUF 5,000 and maximum HUF 200,000, to the account specified in this Decision, with reference to the court case number (decision number), within 40 (forty) days and provided proof of this payment to the liquidator.

The Court established the insolvency of the debtor based on Section 27 (2) a) of the Bankruptcy Act.

The Court has chosen the liquidator for appointment by random electronic selection.

The proceedings were opened as main proceedings pursuant to Council Regulation (EC) No. 1346/2000 of 29 May 2000 on Insolvency Proceedings.
